



C&G 2365 Level 3 Diploma in Electrical Installations (Buildings and Structures) (Full-Time)

The C&G 2365 Level 3 Diploma in Electrical Installations (Buildings and Structures) is a Full-Time, Further Education course designed for students who are interested in the Building Engineering industry. This is located in the Building Engineering Services (BES) department.

Qualified electricians earn salaries between £16,000 to £38,000 per year, and this programme will provide you with the necessary and desirable practical skills and qualifications to enable you to acquire employment in electrical installation.

This Level 3 course is now closely aligned to the Electrotechnical Apprenticeship qualification.

Entry Requirements

Prior to gaining entry onto this Level 3 qualification, students will require the City & Guilds 2365 Level 2 Diploma in Electrical Installations (Buildings and Structures).

Career Prospects

After achieving the previous Level 2 2365, students can gain employment as electrical labourers or an electrician's mate. However, on completion of this Level 3 2365, students can gain employment as a JIB registered Electrical Improver.

When the 2365 Level 2 and 3 have both been concluded, candidates only then need to complete their work-based evidence (along with the AM2), to qualify as electricians with NVQ Level 3.

The recognised progression route is onto the NVQ Level 3 Diploma. The Diploma will provide a fully qualified electrician status. You will also be able to apply for a JIB Registered Electrician Gold Card.

Please note - If on completion of this 2365 L3 course you wish to progress onto the NVQ Level 3 Diploma; this will require a portfolio of evidence taken from on-site experience. It also requires passing of the AM2 practical assessment.
