

Construction and the Built Environment: Construction Management HND (Full-Time)

The HND in Construction & the Built Environment: Construction Management is a one-year full-time Uni-level programme designed for students who have experience of, or work in, the construction industry.

The course will help you build upon your skills in site management, contracts and management and Building Information Modelling (BIM), sustainability and the management of complex buildings.

You will study key areas such as construction-based law, alternative modern methods of construction (AMC's), site safety and in addition to site management techniques, you will also learn about contract procedures, project management and the construction risk assessment process.

Entry Requirements

Students must be 18, and hold the following qualifications:

Completion of the HNC in Construction and the Built Environment or an equivalent qualification in a relevant construction related discipline. Attainment of GCSEs in English and Maths at grade C or above.

Career Prospects

Graduates will have further employment prospects in construction management disciplines, including Site Management, Facilities Managers and Project Management. This course is highly regarded by employers in the construction industry.

Graduates can also go onto further study of a level 6 top-up qualification in a related discipline.
