CARERS AND YOUNG ADULT CARERS

Carers and young adult carers will:

- be invited to attend a designated day of enrolment
- be asked to voluntarily complete a Pattern of Care form to identify individual support needs
- be offered the opportunity to carry a Carers Card
- have the opportunity to be supported by a designated resilience officer
- have the College admin fee waived at enrolment (young adult carers aged between 16-25 only)
- receive free transport (if applicable) and free meals if eligible for FCF funding.

The College holds the QSCS Award (Quality Standard Carer Support) to further support its learners.



YOUNG PEOPLE IN CARE, CARE LEAVERS AND UNACCOMPANIED ASYLUM SEEKER CHILDREN

The Student Support team work closely with local authorities to identify young people in care/care leavers to ensure a continuous transition to college. Young people in care, care leavers and unaccompanied asylum seeker children will:

- be invited to attend a designated day of enrolment
- have the opportunity to be supported by a designated wellbeing officer
- have the College admin fee waived at enrolment
- be eligible for free clothing and equipment required for their course
- receive free transport (if applicable) and free meals if eligible for FCF funding.

VETERANS OF THE ARMED FORCES AND STUDENTS WITH PARENTS SERVING IN THE ARMED FORCES

Veterans of the armed forces and service children will:

- be invited to attend a designated day of enrolment
- have the opportunity to be supported by a designated wellbeing officer
- receive free transport (if applicable) and free meals if eligible for EMA/WGLG/FCF funding.

STUDENTS WITH REFUGEE/ ASYLUM SEEKER STATUS

The College support students of all nationalities including refugees, who will receive:

- 1-1 drop-in support
- help with completing student finance applications - if eligible.
